

Admission Procedure

It has been agreed that the maximum admission number into the reception class shall be 15 children per year. The school has a one-point entry system. All children may start school in the September of the academic year in which they are five.

Admissions Policy

Parents wishing their child to attend the school should apply online. These should be returned directly to Derbyshire CC.

The Headteacher is always pleased to show parents around the school and answer any questions. School will also have regard to individual pupils whose special needs can be best met by the school.

When considering applications to the school the following order of priority will be adopted;

- 1. Looked After Children and all previously looked after children including those who appear (to the admissions authority) to have been in state care outside England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted.
- 2. Children living in the normal area served by the school (including those in another L.A.'s area).
- 3. Children not living in the normal area served by the school, but have brothers/sisters attending the school at the time of their admission.
- 4. In the case of Voluntary Controlled Church Schools, children whose parents request a place on religious grounds.
- 5. Out of area children whose parents have requested a place.

Where in the case of 2, 3, 4 or 5 above, choices have to be made between children satisfying the same criteria; those children living nearest to the school (measured by the straight line distance) will be given preference.

In the case of section 5, all requests will be notified by the Easter prior to the child's admission during the following school year, beginning in September. Any other enquiries regarding admissions should be directed to Derbyshire County Council admissions Team.
