We aim to provide a thriving, inspiring and stimulating learning environment where children achieve the very best they are capable of because all the staff value their different learning styles. Kirk Langley Church of England Primary School is committed to Christian values where children, parents/carers and our community know us by our actions.

#### Within a Christian ethos we aim to:

- Promote a positive attitude to life-long learning, nurturing the development of self-esteem; leading to aspirational, independent learners that are prepared to be challenged and take risks in a diverse and ever changing world.
- Provide the children with valuable experiences and opportunities, through a broad, balanced and exciting curriculum, where learning is purposeful and engaging.
- Use a variety of teaching strategies and resources effectively and creatively; encouraging each child to progress and attain to the highest possible standards, in relation to their age and ability.

- Explicitly promote the fundamental British values of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs through a 'living' curriculum.

# Introduction

We believe that an effective partnership between home and school is beneficial in supporting children in their learning. As a result, we introduced in March 2020 - Class Dojo. Class Dojo is a communication application (app) which connects parents/carers, teachers and children.

Staff use it as a communication platform to encourage children and to get parents/carers engaged in their children's learning. It has a reward component and a communication system. Teachers can communicate with children on a 1:1 messaging service or via the class page where general class messages will be shared. Teachers create Home Learning content including videos and interactive tasks for children to complete as part of their home or remote learning.

Children can engage in their learning in school and home by posting evidence of work they are proud of in their portfolio and responding to tasks and feedback from their teacher.

Parents can be kept informed of class events and see evidence of their child's work and learning environment.

Class Dojo has four main elements:

# **Expectations for staff:**

- Teachers are encouraged to post updates on their class page. The number of posts teachers make and the content, which has to be appropriate or relevant, is at the discretion of the teacher. During periods of isolation teachers should add the specified number of sessions stated in the remote learning policy.
- It is not expected that teachers will need the app on their mobile device, please be mindful of the impact this may have on your personal time.
- Teachers must make themselves fully aware of the children who are in LA care or who do not have permission to have their photographs shared on Class Dojo, and ensure that these children do not appear on Class Dojo.
- To share home learning with children
- To follow all safeguarding polices and staff code of conduct

## Parent/Carer Responsibilities:

- If you have any questions, queries or concerns, do feel free to message your child's teacher on Class Dojo and they will also keep in touch with you via Class Dojo. You can still leave messages at the school office, send e-mails and communicate with the school in the same ways you use to. If a matter cannot be easily resolved via the messaging service, the class teacher will arrange a phone call or meeting.
- Teachers will not be able to respond to your messages on weekends and any other time outside of the stated period. If it is an urgent concern or query, please do follow the channels of communications that you would have done previously.
- Parents must ensure that their child uses Class Dojo safely and support them in uploading evidence of learning.

## Pupil Responsibilities:

- Agree and follow the school rules for Class Dojo (appendix 1)
- Encourage parents to engage with Class Dojo
- Complete assigned tasks and respond to feedback on Class Dojo

## Leadership Responsibilities:

- Monitoring of the policy will be by Senior Leaders who can view each Class Dojo page at regular intervals to ensure the policy is being adhered to, and address any misuse with the relevant parties.
- Senior Leaders will regularly review the use of Class Dojo to ensure it is effective in achieving the aims of this policy.
