Our Representatives.

- At Kirk Langley C of E Primary School, we are represented by 14 children within our School Council and 14 within our Eco-Advocates of Change. This consists of 2 children from each year group.
- Our children attend and participate in group meetings and discussions each half term. These take place in our dedicated 'council' office, supported by Miss Owen-Salmon and Mrs Walker- although led mainly by children.

How our children are elected.

- We use a voting system to elect the roles of the school council and eco-advocates of change. Children are given time to prepare for their 'spotlight' moment to allow their ideas to shine brightly to their audience. Once all candidates have given their speeches, each school member votes for their chosen candidate.
- Children who are voted, remain in their post for a whole school year and identify themselves with a badge to ensure all children recognise their role.
